



Ashorne Hill completes £2.5 million refurbishment project

Ashorne Hill has recently completed its biggest training centre and conference venue facilities investment in over fifty years. With a budget of £2.5 million pounds, Deeley Construction Ltd. worked with Ashorne Hill Management College near Leamington Spa to upgrade the onsite kitchen and restaurant facilities and create a new façade for the existing 1960s wing, to better complement the exterior of the Grade II-listed manor house which houses the traditional period areas of the college.

This refurbishment has transformed the dining room into a beautiful new space including a mezzanine level – creating the capacity to serve 200 guests. The interior has been completely transformed into a welcoming space perfect for dining, private functions and weddings, with a beautifully-laid patio overlooking the spectacular grounds - perfect for a drinks reception, with outdoor lighting showcasing the true beauty of the Grade II listed manor house.



From the outset Ashorne Hill wanted to achieve a highly original design-feel for the refurbishment project and had great faith in the ability of local businesses to help them achieve this.

This major project has given a real boost to the local economy with all sub-contractors working on the project based in the West Midlands. Along with contractors, many local craftsmen were commissioned to design and manufacture bespoke items such as furniture, fabric and artwork.
